Community Served

1. Georgians with a disability, their family members or legal guardians/representatives who request Assistive Technology, home modifications, or vehicle modifications as defined by the program policies.
2. Employers who want to accommodate their worksite for an employee with a disability who is a resident of Georgia.
3. Individuals who can demonstrate the ability to repay the loan.

Assistive Technology

Assistive Technology includes a lot of different kinds of equipment. Some examples are home and vehicle modifications, communication devices, adapted computer equipment, hearing aids, ramps and wheelchairs.

1. Apply for Credit-Able services by completing all of the forms in the application packet.

3. The Credit-Able Program Coordinator will then contact you to discuss options, any other information required to proceed with your request, and the next steps.
