#### **SUMMARY**

The GettingAhead Association is a statewide, member driven organization with the purpose of fostering financial literacy and economic independence among our members. It is a collaborative effort between community-based organizations (our founding partners include: Georgia Credit Union Affiliates, Consumer Credit Counseling, Georgia Department of Labor/Vocational Rehabilitation, Cobb Micro Enterprise Center, Georgia Micro Enterprise Network) and affiliated Georgia Credit Unions (MACO Educators Credit Union, Gwinnett Federal Credit Union, and MembersFirst Credit Union, and The Coca-Cola Company Family Federal Credit Union).

Services offered by the GettingAhead Association include financial education (in the schools and in the community), access to affordable financial services at participating Georgia credit unions (checking, savings, financing for cars and homes), small business start-up services, credit counseling/repair, and cooperative buying services. Depending on the service, it may be offered directly through the GettingAhead Association or through one of our partners.

- Support organizational networking among those working with populations seeking to improve their financial well-being
